Pyott Road Construction Project to Resume, Construction anticipated to Start week of June 1, 2010

Construction work on Pyott Road (a County Highway) will resume south of Rakow Road in front of Lake in the Hills Airport beginning the week of June 1, 2010, weather permitting. The work will involve reconstruction of shoulders, final grading and restoration, and application of final surface pavement and roadway striping.

The actual paving on Pyott Road is anticipated to begin Monday, June 1st with the entire project to be completed within two weeks after start of construction. Pavement marking will follow shortly after the paving is completed. The work is being undertaken by the Village of Lake in the Hills in association with safety improvements at the Lake in the Hills Airport.

The project is anticipated to be totally completed in June 2010 and will result in a new alignment for Pyott Road. Motorists should expect delays during the shoulder work and paving operations and allow for extra travel time during this final phase of the project. Project updates will be posted to the McHenry County Division of Transportation website as necessary throughout the duration of the project.
