

ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, this County Board has heretofore adopted the International Mechanical Code 2000, and

WHEREAS, it is in the interests of the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of McHenry County; and your Planning and Development Committee is of the opinion that the updated International Mechanical Code 2006 should be adopted, and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid International Mechanical Code 2006 has been filed in the office of the County Clerk of McHenry County since October 1, 2008 and in the Planning and Development Department pursuant to 55 ILCS 5/5-6001

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of McHenry County, Illinois that the International Mechanical Code 2006 and the same is hereby adopted by reference to 55 ILCS 5/5-6001 for multi-family, commercial and industrial structures, effective January 1, 2009, with the following modifications:

CHAPTER 1 - ADMINISTRATION

SECTION 101 – GENERAL

Section 101.1 -“Title” - Insert “County of McHenry” to the second line *[name of jurisdiction]*.

SECTION 106 - PERMITS

Section 106.5.2 -“Fee schedule” - Insert “in the fee schedule adopted by the County Board”.

Section 106.5.3 -“Fee refunds” - Delete the entire section.

SECTION 108 – VIOLATIONS

Section 108.4 -“Violation penalties” - Insert “Petty Offense” to the seventh line *[specify offense]*, with “\$500.00” to the eighth line *[amount]* and “six months” to the ninth line *[number of days]*

Section 108.5 -“Stop work order” - Insert “\$200.00” to the thirteenth line *[amount]* and “\$500.00” to the fourteenth line *[amount]*

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the penalty for violation of any of the provisions of the International Mechanical Code 2006 shall be a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and that each day that the violation exists shall be considered a separate offense; nothing herein, however, shall preclude injunction proceedings.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the penalty for violation of any of the provisions of the International Mechanical Code 2006 shall be a fine not less than two hundred dollars (\$200) or not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and that each day that the violation exists shall be considered a separate offense; nothing herein, however, shall preclude enforcement proceedings by means other than a fine, including injunction proceedings.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that if there is any conflict between this code and other codes adopted by the County, the most restrictive provision shall prevail.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the International Mechanical Code 2006 becomes effective upon passage of this Ordinance and that the County Clerk is hereby directed to distribute a certified copy of this Ordinance to the County Administrator, the Director of Planning and Development and the State's Attorney.
