## **BURGLAR SENTENCED TO 4 YEARS IN PRISON**

Louis A. Bianchi, McHenry County State's Attorney, announces that Kitt Lechner, 28, of the City of McHenry was sentenced today to four years in the Illinois Department of Corrections for two counts of the Class 1 felony offense of Residential Burglary.

On June 4, 2011 and June 11, 2011, Kitt Lechner and his wife, Grace Wright burglarized several residences in the City of McHenry. Also accompanying them for the residential burglaries were their two young children. Items taken from the residences included jewelry, a watch and several coin containers. Kitt Lechner was found in possession of some of the items taken, while others were unrecovered.

This case was investigated by the City of McHenry Police Department and was prosecuted by Assistant State's Attorney Demetri Tsilimigras, Deputy Chief of the Criminal Division, and Assistant State's Attorney Andrew Mueller.
